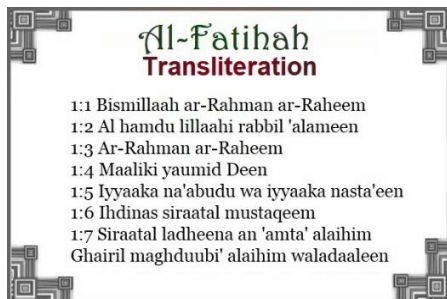
It is rightly placed at the beginning of the Quran, as summing up, in marvelously terse and comprehensive words, man's relation to Allah in contemplation and prayer.

1. In the name of Allah, most Gracious, Most Merciful;
2. Praise be to Allah, The Cherisher and Sustainer of the Worlds;
3. Most Gracious, Most Merciful;
4. Master of the Day of Judgment;
5. Thee do we worship, And Thine aid we seek.
6. Show us the straight way,
7. The way of those on whose Thou has bestowed Thy Grace, those whose (portion) Is not wrath. And who go not astray.

Recite the **Surat Al-Fatiha 100 times daily**. This is the way you will be doing it daily for easy recitation. You will be reciting after every salat.

Salatul Fajir ----- 30 times

Salatul Zuhr ----- 25 times

Salatul Asir ----- 20 times

Salatul Magrib ----- 15 times

Salatul Ishai ----- 10 times
